From our Nurse Sally

Dehydration

Children with physical and intellectual disabilities are at risk of poor hydration during the summer months. Signs to watch for are; dark smelly urine, less wet nappies, dry lips, constipation and poor skin turgor (the skin on the back of the hand is slow to return to its normal position when pulled up slightly).

Risk Factors

- · Rides in hot vehicles
- Being unable to ask for a drink.
- · Unable to communicate thirst
 - · Being PEG fed

If you notice your child has any of the above signs or you have any concerns contact the Community Health Nurse Sally at Sally.Steffanoni@health.wa.gov.au to discuss increasing the amount of water your child is given at school with their feeds / or at meal times.
