For Science we have been learning all about our senses - including sight, sound, taste, smell and touch. Children were tasked with finding an item they can see within the classroom and had a go at drawing it.

In HASS this term our focus is on community helpers. So far, we have looked at different types of people within the community. For example, police officers, fire fighters, doctors, teachers, dentists, vets, postal workers etc. The children have learnt that these are safe people we can go to for help if we need it.
