Each week the children explore a different literacy text - last week we focused on 'Sharing a Shell' by Julia Donaldson. Students engaged with the story in multiple ways, listening to the text being read aloud, looking at the text independently and they also watched an animated story book online. The story explores the importance of sharing with others. Linking to the text, the children looked at different types of shells, using magnifying glasses to see the different colours, textures and patterns. They even had a chance to play with the shells in a fun sensory tray, they did some clam painting and created their very own shell art.

We have also been participating in the cooking program, which the students have been enjoying. Last week we made Nachos.

Each Friday, Room 25 visits the sensory room, engaging with the various resources available. This is a good opportunity for us educators to see what each child enjoys, what they are drawn to, including what helps them to regulate themselves. We can then try to incorporate these tools in the classroom where we can.
